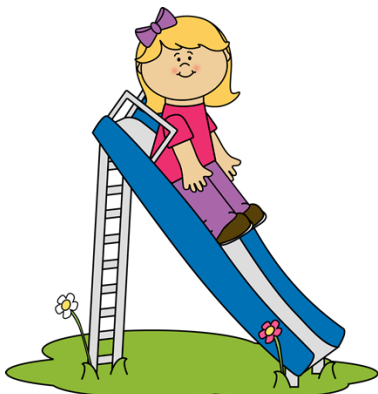
California Area Public Library Summer Reading Program 2016
